The firm developed an overall concept for a multipurpose asphalt pad, splash pad, playground, additional future parking with a large soccer field, tennis courts, etc, which will be implemented over a 5 year period. The budget for implementation is estimated at over 1.2 million. The firm presented the concept at a Public Meeting, which was approved by council. Phase I, includes the splash pad, multipurpose asphalt pad and the base for the playground. The concept goal was to integrate with the existing typography as much as possible and restrict potential adverse impact on the storm pond and the geothermal piping laid throughout the existing library site. The firm worked with various departments at the Town of Innisfil to present a coherent, cost effective plan.
