


### Sculpture - Vaughan Commercial Property

#### The Storm

The Storm is an interactive sculpture that captures one of the most dynamic, powerful and energetic moments in the seasonal cycle of Lake Ontario. The Storm is a collage of materials including a spiral of flowing native grass, waves of concrete and a mounded landform spiraling up to the galvanized stee lightning strike. The spiral follows the Golden Sector, an athematical rate the spresent in many elements in the natural world. The galvanized metal struct symbolizes lightning stretching over the lake and the salis of the boats that mo across the water. The Storm will change in appearance from different angles an at different times of the day or year.

## Ajax Art Sculpture "The Storm"

"The Storm" is an 8 m tall metal sculpture located on the Ajax Waterfront adjacent to the 'Waterfront Trail'. The design is inspired by a sailing experience one of our Landscape Architects, Amanda Berry, had while racing on Lake Ontario. A violent rain and lightning storm suddenly appeared. The 3D lightning bolt combined with "concrete waves" and a spiral of tall grasses are meant to portray movement of water and sails as the viewer walks around, without having actual moving parts.
